WELCOME TO BESANÇON

Besançon, the place of birth of Energy Cities, is the host of our 2025 annual forum.

It is a city with extraordinary surroundings and generous nature assets, where you can reach wide open green spaces within the town itself in just a few minutes! With over 2000 years of history, the city was built on an exceptional natural site: an almost perfect loop of the Doubs River, dominated by 7 hills that surround the old town.

Its energy and climate policies and innovative projects have made it one of the pioneering local authorities in the green transition in France. It is committed to becoming a sustainable and resilient territory by leading initiatives and boosting local cooperation. It has been awarded the **European Energy Award Gold (EEA)** several years, and it is continually working to keep improving and renew the label.



HOW TO GET TO BESANÇON

BY PLANE

Besançon can be easily reached from five international airports:

- **EUROAIRPORT BASEL MULHOUSE FREIBURG** (150 km): at this airport there is a shuttle bus to Saint-Louis station, from there you can take a train to Besançon Viotte station that also stops in Mulhouse and Belfort (*duration between 2h and 2h30*).
- **GENEVA AIRPORT** (170 km): at this airport there is a shuttle train to Genève Cornavin Station, from there you can take a train to Besançon Viotte station that stops in Bourg-en-Bresse (*duration of 4h*).
- **LYON - SAINT-EXUPERY AIRPORT** (240 km): at this airport there is a tram that goes to Lyon Part Dieu station where you can take a direct train to Besançon Viotte station (*duration of approximately 2h40*).
- **PARIS - ORLY AIRPORT** (400 km): at this airport there are to options to get to the train station Gare de Lyon where you can you can take a direct train to Besançon Viotte station:
 - Metro (Line 14) to Gare de Lyon station.
 - RER train Line Orlyval B to Antony Station + Metro (line 14) to Gare de Lyon.
- **PARIS - ROISSY - CHARLES DE GAULLE** (430 km): at this airport there are to options to get to the train station Gare de Lyon:
 - RER B train to Gare de Lyon station.
 - Metro (Line 14) Gare de Lyon station.

Gare Viotte is in Besançon's city center, offering multiple connections to major French and European cities:

Gare Besançon - Franche-Comté TGV is 15 minutes away from the city centre. It is connected to Gare Viotte with a TER shuttle bus.
